ARCHELON was founded in 1983 under the name "The Sea Turtle Protection Society of Greece" and is a non-profit association with the aim of studying and protecting sea turtles and their habitats.

- For the last 40 years ARCHELON has been active in the most important nesting beaches of Greece (Zakynthos, Peloponnese, Crete) monitoring and protecting the reproductive activity of loggerhead sea turtles
- Since 2000, ARCHELON has been studying the origin, migrations, and growth rate of sea turtle populations (Amvrakikos gulf)
- Since 1994, the ARCHELON Sea Turtle Rescue Centre (in Glyfada) treats injured or sick sea turtles rescued from around the country

ARCHELON in numbers

75-110

km of nesting beaches are monitored every summer 1.500

sea turtles have been treated at the Rescue Centre
